TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

Brief History

The New York State Financial Aid Administrators Association (NYSFAAA) was founded in 1968 by a group of people involved in the financial aid process. They, and others, felt a need for an association that would provide unified representation and the means of communication among financial aid personnel in the higher education community, and would provide educational programs for the professional development of its members.

One hundred forty-seven members elected officers and councilpersons at-large at NYSFAAA's Charter Conference held in Syracuse in October 1968. Committees such as Federal Relations, State Relations, and Professionalism, among others, were established to deal with concerns that arose from changes within programs, to suggest and respond to legislation, to provide training, and to facilitate communications among the financial aid community and federal and state governments. NYSFAAA's first annual meeting was held in October 1969, in Albany NY.
